

This reminds me of Cesar Chavez because he fought for equal rights of Mexican migrant farm workers.






Persevered

This makes me feel very relieved because if no one stood up for how people with AIDS are treated, the everyone would still be afraid of people with AIDS.






Viewed Problems as Opportunities

She saved a lot of people because if she did not do this there would be explosions everywhere and we would be wasting water to put out the explosions and we would have a BIG drought!






